Sub:- State Election Commission – 4th Ordinary elections to Gram Panchayats, 2013 – Clarification on eligibility to contest to the office of the Sarpanch & Ward Members of Gram Panchayats – Regarding.

Ref:- Letter No.P5/130/2011, dated 9.7.2013 from the District Panchayat Officer, Khammam.

Clarification sought	Clarification given
i) A Co-operative Society Member is eligible for contest for G.P. elections or not.	Yes. He is eligible to contest.
ii) Is there any further extension after issue of cut of date by 30-5-1995 for filing nomination who have more than 2(two) children after 30-5-1995.	No.
iii) When a candidate having (3) children after 30-5-1995, but one child was expired and at present the individual having two children only, is he eligible for contesting or not.	Yes. Eligible to contest. No. of living children a person is having as on the date of scrutiny is crucial here.
iv) If one Woman belongs to ST community marries a non-tribal person and changes her surname of her husband, whether she is eligible for the ST reserved category nomination.	Yes. If she can produce ST community certificate.
v) If the person born to inter married couple in which wife belongs to ST and husband belongs to non-tribal community, is the children of the inter married couple are eligible for ST reservation status.	No
vi) In 1 st delivery on 27.5.2007 he has one child and again in 2 nd delivery on 28.2.2012 he has twins, whether he is eligible for contest or not.	Yes. He is eligible as already clarified in SEC Lr.No.877/SEC-B2/2013, dated 6.7.2013
