In the references cited, the State Election Commission issued instructions with regard to preparation, publication and printing of Gram Panchayat Photo Electoral Rolls with reference to 01.01.2013 as qualifying date. The preparation of the Gram Panchayat Photo Electoral Rolls is to be completed by 20.03.2013. In the reference 1st cited, number of copies of electoral rolls to be printed has been worked out as 100. Out of the 100 copies printed, 45 copies were earmarked for supply to the political parties.

One copy of the finally published electoral rolls is to be supplied free of cost to each Recognised political party and to each Registered political party with a reserved symbol. For others including Registered political parties without a reserved symbol and independent candidates copies may be provided on payment of actual cost (cost of xeroxing or printing, as the case may be).

As on date, there are 6 Recognised National parties; 2 Recognised State parties in the State of Andhra Pradesh; 5 Recognised State parties in other States; and one Registered political party with a reserved symbol which are eligible for supply of one copy of finally published Gram Panchayat Photo Electoral Roll free of cost. A list of political parties (14) **which are entitled for supply of electoral rolls free of cost** is enclosed as Annexure-I.

Further, there are 59 Registered political parties without a reserved symbol (Annexure-II) which are **not entitled for supply of Gram Panchayat Photo Electoral Rolls free of cost**. Copies of electoral rolls can be provided to them **on payment of actual cost**.

As there are only 14 political parties mentioned in Annexure-I, which are entitled for supply of copies of electoral roll free of cost, it is suggested that only 20 copies may be got printed initially out of 45 copies earmarked for political parties. Further, depending upon the demand for supply of copies on payment of actual cost by any of the Registered political parties without a reserved symbol and independent candidates, additional copies may be generated (xeroxed / printed). This will reduce the quantum of expenditure on printing of electoral rolls.

Keeping in view the above factors, the Collectors and District Election Authorities; Chief Executive Officers of Zilla Praja Parishads and the District Panchayat Officer are requested to work out the requirement of copies of electoral rolls to be printed for their respective districts.
